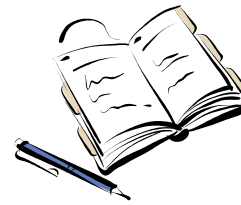
Bridge House

Course Dates for Elementary - Advanced

You can start on **ANY Monday**, but you may prefer to start on one of our main entry dates, either at the **beginning** of a course:

or in the **middle** of a course:

General English with Exam Preparation

15 hours tuition per week

These courses are suitable for students at good intermediate level and above.

Study for these Cambridge ESOL exams:

- FCE (First Certificate in English)
- CAE (Certificate in Advanced English)
- CPE (Certificate of Proficiency in English)

The exam preparation part of your course will include training in exam technique, development of reading, writing, listening and speaking skills, practice with past papers and individual guidance.

CPE 15 Mar—18 Jun (14 weeks)
 Tue 31 Aug—10 Dec (15 weeks)

Written exams normally take place during the final week of the course.

¹ Exam takes place on Sat 13 Mar.

² Students may join the course on any Monday in July.

³ Exam takes place on Sat 6 Mar.

Teachers' Course

A 2-week course, with a 40-hour programme for English Language teachers with at least a good Upper Intermediate level of English.

Course Start Date: Aug 2

Course fees **£730**

Includes materials, tuition fees and single room accommodation.
